REMINDERS

TOYS FROM HOME- We would like to politely ask that children do not bring in toys from home as we are finding that these can get lost or broken and are causing upset between children wanting to play with other children's toys.

CAR PARK -Could we please ask parents not to use the car park at drop off and pick up for the safety of children arriving and being collected and to also park considerately by not blocking the entrance, driveways or parking directly on corners.
