OUR CURRICULUM



Books, Stories and Rhymes- This half term we developed our literacy and communication skills with Books, Stories and Rhymes. We dressed up in our favourite characters, acted out stories and explored sensory trays linked to different stories and characters. We used letters in different ways and practiced our pre writing and early writing skills through mark making and other activities.



Spring- We developed our understanding of the world by exploring Spring. We looked at changes in the weather and what Spring brings. We discussed baby animals and new life with the small world farm. We made daffodil and Spring flower prints with paint. We used flower cutters in the playdough and explored different sensory trays with spring colours.



In the Garden and Minibeasts- For the last part of the term we have been finding out about minibeasts and the garden, we have been weeding and planting new seeds and flowers, we will be measuring how much they grow to develop our Maths and learning about taking responsibility and looking after living things. We have been moving like different minibeasts to be physical and looking at the patterns they have, measuring them and looking at how many legs, wings, eyes they have which again is all helping our Maths skills to develop.
