# REMINDERS

TOYS FROM HOME- We would like to politely ask that children do not bring in toys from home as we are finding that these can get lost or broken and are causing upset between children wanting to play with other children's toys.

**CAR PARK** -Could we please ask parents not to use the car park at drop off and pick up for the safety of children arriving and being collected and to also park considerately by not blocking the entrance, driveways or parking directly on corners.

However, we would like to make you aware that we may occasionally have parents that need to use the car park for drop off or pick up due to medical reasons, this has been agreed with management in order to support their needs. WATER BOTTLES- Please can we remind you to send your child with a drink every day in a named water bottle LABELLING-Please make sure that you child's belongings are always labelled e.g clothing; lunch box; bottle.

LUNCHES- Could we please ask that if your child is only attending for an afternoon session that they have lunch at home, if possible, rather than bringing in a packed lunch as we are finding that they are missing out on a large portion of their session eating lunch.

#### 30 HOUR FUNDING-
