REMINDERS

TOYS FROM HOME- We would like to politely ask that children do not bring in toys from home as we are finding that these can get lost or broken and are causing upset between children wanting to play with other children's toys.

CAR PARK - Could we please ask parents not to use the car park at drop off and pick up for the safety of children arriving and being collected and to also park considerately by not blocking the entrance or parking directly on the corner.

LABELLING-Please make sure that you child's belongings are always labelled e.g clothing; lunch box; bottle.

LUNCHES- Could we please ask that if your child is only attending for an afternoon session that they have lunch at home if possible, rather than bringing in a packed lunch as we are finding that they are missing out on a large portion of their session eating lunch.

OUTDOOR CLOTHING-

With the weather now being warmer please remember to apply suncream to your child before they arrive for their session and send a named sun hat.

Could we also ask that children have spare clothes due to lots of water play.

30 HOUR FUNDING-

For anyone currently eligible for 30 hours funding please be reminded that confirmation must be done 3 months from the date you applied to receive the extra hours, then every 3 months after. You will receive a text and/or email 4 weeks before your reconfirmation deadline. Please ensure you renew your code before 31^{st} August for next term.
